Areas of Consideration / Improvement:

- (1) 2nd quarter of Girls game: Lead calling across the lane to pick up block charge. What did the slot see?
- (2) 2nd Quarter 3:27: A1 dribble drive down the center of the lane from the trail side and just below the lane line lead makes a call.
 - a. At what point should trail release the play to lead?
 - b. Should lead pass and let Trail keep it?
 - c. What should C do in that play?
- (3) 1st Quarter: A1 shot was blocked by B1 (number 21) down low on the trail side but was fouled by B2 (number 15) from the back side off the C side. The foul occurred across B1 arm. Trail called the foul on B1.
- (4) 2nd quarter at 1:57: A1 recovers ball and fall to the floor and C called traveling. This was a transition play and C stayed home to make the call. Good move by C but the questions what caused the travel?
 - a. Did contact by B1 cause A1 to go to the floor?
 - b. Did A1 have clear possession of the ball before falling to the floor?
 - c. Could C have waited another second and allowed the play to continue?
- (5) 4th Quarter at 3:02: A play going to the basket out of Trail. Trail stays with the play and the sequence was as follow. A1 dribble, whistle, ball hit the floor after whistle and A1 taps the ball into the basket. Initially trail counted the basket. C went to C and discussed the play. This resulted in the basket being cancelled and the ball played out of bound. The crew got the play right.
 - a. Would it have looked better if Trail had delayed counting the basket until he talked to C.
 - b. Should Lead have an input into the play?
 - c. Why did C communicate to Trail instead of Lead?
- (6) 3rd Quarter: 6:24 A1 goes up in lead primary and C makes a call on B1. Should C lay off that play and let lead live with the results? Did C call add to the game?
 - a. Should trail have had a look at that play?
 - b. What is the call regression on this play that everyone will believe?
- (7) 3rd quarter 3:57: A1 goes to the basket and was slightly bumped by B1. The basket went in and A1 landed cleanly to the floor. No interruption of balance, speed and rhythm. A1 team was leading by 15 points. Lead calls a foul, counts the basket and A1 gets one free throw.
 - a. What was the consequence of the whistle?
 - b. Did it add to the game?
 - c. Did it take away from the game?
 - d. Was the contact incidental and could have been passed on?
 - e. Was the referee managing the game to ensure clean play for the remainder of the game?
